  - b. **Gun Show** – The gun show is on for June 19 & 20 at the Acton Fair Grounds. 135 dealer agreements have been sent out. Contact Shawn Cavanaugh to sign up for a time slot where you can help out at the event. Food will be outsourced to Black Bear catering, from which we are expecting a cut of the profits.
  - c. **Pheasant Committee** – Tim Corbin reported on the situation this year with state birds. Only adult birds will be purchased by the state this year due to concerns about EEE. We can ask for 100 state birds and possibly leverage other clubs sites to raise them, or we can go in with Kezar Falls who will be working outside of the state this year and raising birds from chicks. The advantage of going in with Kezar Falls is that we can put the birds out wherever we want. The con is we would not get reimbursed by the state. If we purchased 100 chicks it would cost us about \$1,000 to raise and feed them.
  - d. **Trap Range** – Frank Covie submitted a multi-page proposal to board members and club officers on the Trap range. All are requested to review the information so it can be discussed at the next meeting in June. We do not anticipate a vote in June, but rather to have a discussion on the proposal in June for a vote in July.
